

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST.** A purchase will not improve your chances of winning. The chances of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received. Visit [steamwhistle.ca](http://steamwhistle.ca) between 12:01am (EST) Wednesday, February 15<sup>th</sup> -11:59:59 pm (EST) Monday , March 20<sup>th</sup> to fill out your online ballot for entry. Limit one (1) entry per person.

**2. HOW TO PLAY.** To participate, legibly complete the ballot by March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2017. By entering the contest, all participants agree to abide by the contest rules and decisions of the independent contest organization, which are final. All contestants must have completed the ballot including sharing the Canadian Artist they'd like to see win a JUNO Award & why. The ballot must also include their name, age, and all contact information, and entrants must have otherwise complied with these rules and regulations to be declared a winner.

**3. WINNER SELECTION/DRAWS.** On March 23rd, 2017, a random draw will be conducted from all eligible entries received between February 15<sup>th</sup> 2017 to March 20th, 2017 .
