

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST. A purchase will not improve your chances of winning. The chances of winning depend on the total number of eligible entries received. Visit steamwhistle.ca between 12:01am (MDT) March 1st -11:59:59 pm (MDT) March 15th to fill out your ballot for entry. Limit one (1) entry per person.

2. HOW TO PLAY. To participate, legibly complete the ballot by March 15th, 2018. By entering the contest, all participants agree to abide by the contest rules and decisions of the independent contest organization, which are final. All contestants must have completed the ballot including sharing the Canadian Artist/Band they'd like to see perform at the JUNO Awards & why.
